

Mentoring managers

Mentoring managers are responsible to Mrs Turner (Head of Y11). They are responsible for organising the mentoring programme. This involves allocating and planning Year 12 mentors for Y7-11 mentees during the academic year. For more information see Mrs Turner.

Events Managers

Events Managers must assist in the organisation of the principal school events. The biggest of these is the Sixth Form Awards Evening in September, but also KS4 Awards, Open Evenings, Careers Evening and other drama, music and public events. They are responsible to Mrs Gilmour for Awards Evening and other staff for the other events.

Technical Managers

The 'Techies' role is to ensure that all school events receive the desired technical support in terms of lighting, sound and projection. This will include Open Evenings, presentation evenings and (by far the most technical) drama and music productions. Technical skills are essential. Drama and Music events will be led by Mr Dereza and Miss Bray. Other staff will lead on other events.

Charities Managers

The school does a huge amount of charity work and the Charities Managers organise it. This means some publicity work (eg assemblies) as well as planning and delivering the charities programme to the whole school. Mr Wade is the member of staff overseeing charities.

Library Manager

This is a very specific job for someone who wants to be involved in assisting with the organisation of the library (from a 'librarian' point of view) and needs to be an organised individual. Will look after prospectuses in Newport Study. Mrs Beeson will line manage this job.
