

## Entry requirements – entry 2024

Generally, students may be admitted providing they:

- achieve at least **Grade 4 in Mathematics and English Language**
- achieve a minimum of **Grade 5 at GCSE in four subjects**
- only GCSE will be accepted, not other vocational equivalents
- **meet the specific subject requirements detailed below**

In some cases we will consider students for a place at AGS who just miss the grade requirements stated below.

Subject (all A level unless stated)	Specific entry requirement
* Art	Grade 6 at GCSE.
Biology	Grade 7 at GCSE single award or 77 double award, plus grade 7 in Maths.
Business	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language (or English), plus grade 6 in Business Studies, if studied.
Chemistry	Grade 7 at GCSE single award or 77 double award, plus grade 7 in Maths.
Computer Science	Grade 7 at GCSE Maths, plus grade 6 in Computer Science if studied. <b>Also submission of a coding task. Deadline 4pm Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024</b>
*Design Technology	Grade 7 at GCSE or in a related GCSE Design Technology, Product Design or Graphic Products course. <b>Also submission of a DT task. Deadline 4pm Friday 5<sup>th</sup> July 2024</b>
*Drama & Theatre	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language, plus grade 6 in Theatre Studies/Drama if studied. <b>Also submission of a 'Live Theatre Review'. Deadline 4pm Friday 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024</b>
Economics	Grade 7 at GCSE in Maths and 6 in English Language (or English), plus grade 6 in Economics, if studied.
English Language	Grade 6 at GCSE English Language.
English Literature	Grade 6 at GCSE, plus grade 6 in English Language.
Food Science & Nutrition Level 3 Diploma	Grade 6 at GCSE Food Preparation & Nutrition, or similar vocational qualification.
French	Grade 7 at GCSE.
Geography	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language, plus grade 6 in Geography, if studied.
History	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language, plus grade 6 in History, if studied.
Maths	Grade 7 at GCSE.
Maths (Further) <b>DOUBLE A level</b>	Grade 8 at GCSE.
*Music	Grade 6 at GCSE, plus grade 5 in practical and theory.
Philosophy, Religion & Ethics (PRE)	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language, plus grade 6 in RE, if studied.
*Photography	Submission of a quality digital portfolio after Subject Sampling Evening. <b>Submission deadline 4pm 8<sup>th</sup> March 2024</b>
*Physical Education	Grade 6 in GCSE PE, if studied, plus a regular extra-curricular commitment to ONE sport.
Physics	Grade 7 at GCSE single award or 77 double award, plus grade 7 in Maths.
Politics	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language
Psychology	Grade 6 at GCSE in English Language, plus grade 6 in Psychology, if studied.
Spanish	Grade 7 at GCSE.
*Statistics	Grade 6 at GCSE in Maths.

\* These subjects are 'full linear only'. There is no AS option at the half-way stage. You can, of course, still drop it at the end of year 12. **In 2023 all other subjects had an AS available. This is subject to change but the intention is to offer the same opportunities to sit AS levels in 2025 as we are doing in 2024. Optional AS sittings are at the candidates' expense.**

**Remember:** We can accommodate you choosing ANY four subjects.

**Important** After interview all students will be contacted regarding offers. Those who are predicted to meet the grade criteria above will be given 'guaranteed' offers (subject to our standard admissions policy). Students who, on receipt of their GCSE results in August, fail to meet the required grades/terms of their offer will be reviewed in order of merit and places will be awarded where possible, in terms of set capacity in their chosen subjects and if it is in the student's best interests. We will endeavour to fit all students on to appropriate courses.
