Terms of Reference Education Committee

- The terms of reference must be reviewed by the board of trustees annually
- The committee shall have a minimum of three members who are trustees of the board and the majority of members must be trustees of the board
- The chair of this committee must be a trustee and shall be elected at the first committee meeting of the academic year

Education

1. Consider the educational needs of all pupils, the curriculum principles, their implementation and impact
2. Monitor pupil achievement and standards, including specific groups, such as pupil premium, SEND, disadvantaged, looked after children and pupils with English as an additional language, by effective analysis of pupil performance data
3. Monitor the quality of teaching and learning, including performance
4. Monitor teaching capacity including the impact of CPD on pupil achievement and standards
5. Monitor the provision of effective careers, RSE and PSHE education
6. Monitor the engagement of pupils, parents and the wider community in promoting and improving educational performance and wider outcomes for all pupils

Quorum:	A minimum of any three trustees or, where greater, a third of the total number of trustees on the committee.
