



AGSF Lottery Rules updated September 2025

Purpose

The purpose of the Lottery is to raise funds. The PTFA's 60% share of the funds will be used to meet funding requests from the school, providing equipment, resources and opportunities for pupils.

Rules

1. For a cost of £2 per month (i.e. £4 per draw) you will be allocated one number between one and 200.
2. The allocation of the prize fund will depend on the number of people who have entered the draw and will be allocated as follows:

3. The lottery will run from November to October each year with six half-termly draws.
4. As the prize allocation for each band is set at the amount generated by the minimum membership in that band - any unused prize fund (i.e. calculated as 40% of the total annual membership revenue minus prize money allocated) will contribute towards an extra draw in November each year -

an annual Super Draw. All numbers which are included in the sixth draw of the year that have been fully paid will be entered into this draw and there will be one winner of the super draw. This will be drawn by the AGFS Committee.

5. The AGSF Lottery is a private lottery governed by specific legislation, and is open to all parents, carers, staff and friends of Alcester Grammar School. Anyone aged 16 or over can join.
6. Payments must be made by standing order. Subscription runs for a 12-month period, running from November until October each year. Your subscription will renew unless you advise us otherwise.
7. If you join the lottery after the first draw in November, your number will be entered into the next available draw and your monthly standing order should be set up to start from the month of the next draw.
8. For monthly payments, members' numbers will only be entered into the draw if their subscription is up to date. Unless otherwise advised, a member will be deemed to have left the Lottery if their subscription renewal remains unpaid for a period of two months and their membership number will be reallocated.
9. The draw shall be made by random number generation during half-termly PTFA meetings which are open to all. The name and numbers for each draw's winners will be posted in the principal's update newsletter and on the AGFS website (unless you have advised us otherwise).
10. The winning amount will be transferred to the nominated account on your membership application within one week of the draw. If a winner cannot be contacted, the winnings will be placed into PTFA funds after six months.
11. The Lottery will be run by the PTFA. In case of any dispute the decision of the committee is final.
